- **From Madison**, Take Hwy 151 north to Fond du Lac. Turn on Hwy 41 north to Hwy 23 east. Follow Hwy 23 east to Hwy 67 north (right-hand exit). Continue on Hwy 67 north into Elkhart Lake. Turn left on Rhine Street at the four-way stop. Turn left on Osthoff Avenue.
- **From Milwaukee**, Take I-43 north from Milwaukee. Veer left to Exit #97, which turns into Hwy 57 north to Plymouth. Turn left on Hwy 23 west. Follow Hwy 23 west to Hwy 67 (right-hand exit). Continue on Hwy 67 north to Elkhart Lake. Turn left on Rhine Street at the four-way stop. Turn left on Osthoff Avenue.



- **From Northwest Wisconsin**, Take I-90/94 south/east to Hwy 82 east in Mauston. Continue on Hwy 82, which turns into Hwy 23 east. Follow Hwy 23 east to Hwy 67 north (right-hand exit). Take Hwy 67 north into Elkhart Lake. Turn left on Rhine Street at the four-way stop. Turn left on Osthoff Avenue.
